"Here's a wine to make a summer-loving cork dork very happy. It's called *Feliz Creek Cuvee*, from Jepson Estate Vineyards way up there in Mendocino. "Feliz" is Spanish for "happy," and why not?

This is a great summer wine, a blend of (mostly) French Colombard from 50-year-old vines, with varying amounts of Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay thrown in for good measure.

It even tastes happy. Lots of clean, light, refreshing fruit-a bit peachy, a bit floral, with some luscious ripe mango that tails off in a crisp lemon-lime finish.

Pour it with your grilled chicken or veggies, or with one of those nice plump fillets of wild salmon that are all over the markets now.

The price should make you happy too: nine bucks for a wine with real character and structure. And you don't need a degree from U.C. Davis to appreciate it. *Pour it with your grilled chicken or veggies, or with one of those nice plump fillets of wild salmon that are all over the markets now.*"
